In an effort to commemorate the 30th anniversary of the day the Supreme Court struck down Canada’s abortion law, Cambridge Right to Life (CRTL) will host its annual Protest Walk at MP Bryan May’s office on Friday, January 26 from 1:00-2:00 pm. Representatives from CRTL will be meeting with Mr. May at 12:30 pm to present the concerns of its membership.

In the almost 50 years that abortion has been permitted in Canada, 4 million Canadian babies have been killed by abortion.

Prime Minister Trudeau has made “abortion rights” a core mandate of his foreign and domestic policy and is going to great lengths to convince the Canadian public that abortion is a ‘Constitutional right’, a ‘Charter right’ and even a ‘Charter value’.

“We’re not sure if this is an intentional lie or willful ignorance, but this misinformation has certainly caused a kerfuffle and in the process has turned our Charter of Rights and Freedoms upside down,” said CRTL’s Public Relations representative, Camilla Gunnarson.

The Charter exists to protect the right to: freedom of thought, religion, belief, opinion and association. Any government that demands conformity of its citizens, at the expense of these rights, no longer represents a free and democratic country.

Recently, numerous editorial and opinion pieces in the media are blasting Prime Minister Trudeau for his undemocratic attestation provision for employers who apply for Canada Summer Jobs grants, while also pointing out the fact that abortion is not a Charter right.

“Since there is no ‘right’ to abortion in Canada, and our nation has been without a law for the last thirty years, we call on Parliament to follow the Supreme Court’s recommendation to craft a law that protects all pre-born children,” says CRTL Board member, Cathy Meidema.
